

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Wednesday, the 18th day of October, 1876.

1. Mr. KELLY to move, in Committee on the Waste Lands Administration Bill, The following new clause, viz. :—

The Taranaki Provincial Ordinance, intituled "The Public Reserves Trust Ordinance, 1861," is hereby repealed: Provided that nothing in such repeal shall affect or invalidate any contract or agreement with respect to the leasing of any lands which the Board of Trustees thereby constituted were authorized to make under such Ordinance.

All reserves, except educational reserves, of which, but for the repeal of such last-mentioned Ordinance, the Board of Trustees would have had the management, shall be under the management and control of the Waste Lands Board of the Province of Taranaki, subject to any laws or regulation for the time being in force affecting public reserves.

2. Captain MORRIS, on going into Committee of Supply, to move, That the recommendations contained in the Report of the Select Committee on the Petition of A. F. Hardy and Mary Hardy be agreed to.
