WAR VETERANS' ALLOWANCES BILL.

AMENDMENTS proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:—

Clause 6, subclause (1): To omit from this subclause the words “unless they are living together”, and substitute the words “if, in the opinion of the Board, she is living apart from her husband without good cause”.

Clause 8, subclause (1): To omit the words “it is granted” in the third line of the subclause, and substitute the words “the application therefor is received by the Commissioner”.

Clause 8, subclause (2): To insert, after the words “the first such instalment” in the second line of the subclause, the words “or instalments, as the case may be”.
