THE ARTIFICIAL AIDS NOTICE 1954, AMENDMENT NO. 3

PURSUANT to regulation 4 of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947,* the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Artificial Aids Notice 1954, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Artificial Aids Notice 1954† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clause 3 of the principal notice, as amended by clause 2 of the Artificial Aids Notice 1954, Amendment No. 2, is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (d) the word "men's" in each place where it appears.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The principal notice provides for the supply of men's urinals, free of charge under the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947, on the conditions set out in clause 5A of the principal notice. This notice provides for the supply of female urinals on the same conditions.
