PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation Employers and Self-Employed Persons Levies Order 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Employers and Self-Employed Persons Levies Order 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Schedule—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from the item "Customs, shipping and forwarding agency (without transport operations), business of" the

- expressions "40" and "2.35", and substituting, respectively, the expressions "43" and "1.30":
- (b) By omitting from the item "Pottery (hand crafted), manufacture, selling" the expressions "33" and "2.95", and substituting, respectively, the expressions "36" and "1.30":
 - (c) By omitting from the item "Travel agency, business of" the expressions "40" and "2.35", and substituting, respectively, the expressions "43" and "1.30".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Accident Compensation Employers and Self-Employed Persons Levies Order 1989 by reducing the rate of levy payable per \$100 of earnings in respect of—

- (a) Customs, shipping and forwarding agency (without transport operations), business of from \$2.35 to \$1.30:
- (b) Pottery (hand crafted), manufacture, selling from \$2.95 to \$1.30:
- (c) Travel agency, business of from \$2.35 to \$1.30.
