HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 21A of the Machinery Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

2. Applications for registration—(1) Regulation 4 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following paragraph:

Amendment No. 1: S.R. 1980/38
Amendment No. 2: S.R. 1982/60

“(a) A fee of \$30; and”.

(2) The Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1986, increase from \$15 to \$30 the fee payable biennially for the registration of an amusement device.
