THE ALIEN ENLISTMENT EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of
December, 1939.

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Alien Enlistment Emergency Regulations 1939.
2. In these regulations, unless inconsistent with the context,—
“ His Majesty’s New Zealand Forces ” includes the New Zealand Naval Forces, the Defence Forces of New Zealand, and the Royal New Zealand Air Force.
3. An alien may hold a commission or may be entered or enlisted in any of His Majesty’s New Zealand Forces as if he were a British subject.
4. These regulations shall have effect notwithstanding the provisions of section 7 of the Defence Act, 1909, section 95 of the Army Act (Imperial), section 17 of the Air Force Act, 1937, section 95 of the Air Force Act (Imperial), or any other enactment.
