### Bylaws

#### 1 Title

- (1) These bylaws are the Armed Forces Establishments Road Traffic Amendment Bylaws 2004.
- (2) In these bylaws, the Armed Forces Establishments Road Traffic Bylaws 1978<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal bylaws”.

#### 2 Commencement

These bylaws come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

#### 3 Second Schedule amended

The Second Schedule of the principal bylaws is amended by omitting the item relating to Army Camp, Waiouru, and substituting the following item:
