

THE ARMED FORCES (NATIONAL WORK) EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1945

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 24th day of January, 1945

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Armed Forces (National Work) Emergency Regulations 1945.

2. (1) In this regulation the expression "the appropriate Board" means, as the case may require, the Naval Board of New Zealand,

the Army Board, or the Air Board.

- (2) The appropriate Board may from time to time by order authorize the temporary employment of members of the Royal New Zealand Navy, or the Defence Forces, or the Royal New Zealand Air Force, as the case may be, in any kind of work that may be declared by the order to be urgent work of national importance.
- (3) At all times while any such order continues in force it shall be the duty of every member of the Royal New Zealand Navy, or the Defence Forces, or the Royal New Zealand Air Force, as the case may be, to obey all commands given by a superior officer in relation to any work of a kind to which the order relates, and every such command shall be deemed to be a lawful command within the meaning of the Naval Discipline Acts, or the Army Act, or the Air Force Act, as the case may be.

(4) Any such order may at any time be revoked wholly or partly

by a subsequent order made by the appropriate Board.

3. (1) Regulation 17A of the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941, and the Defence Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 6,* are hereby revoked.

(2) All orders and commands, and generally all acts of authority that originated under the said Regulation 17A and are subsisting or in force at the commencement of these regulations, shall enure for the purposes of these regulations as if they had originated under these regulations, and accordingly shall, where necessary, be deemed to have so originated.
