ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 10th day of February
1964

PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Auckland Harbour Board Flag Regulations 1964.

2. The flag described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be the marine flag of the Auckland Harbour Board.

3. The marine flag of the Auckland Harbour Board may be worn by ships (being New Zealand ships) owned and operated by the Board within the following waters:

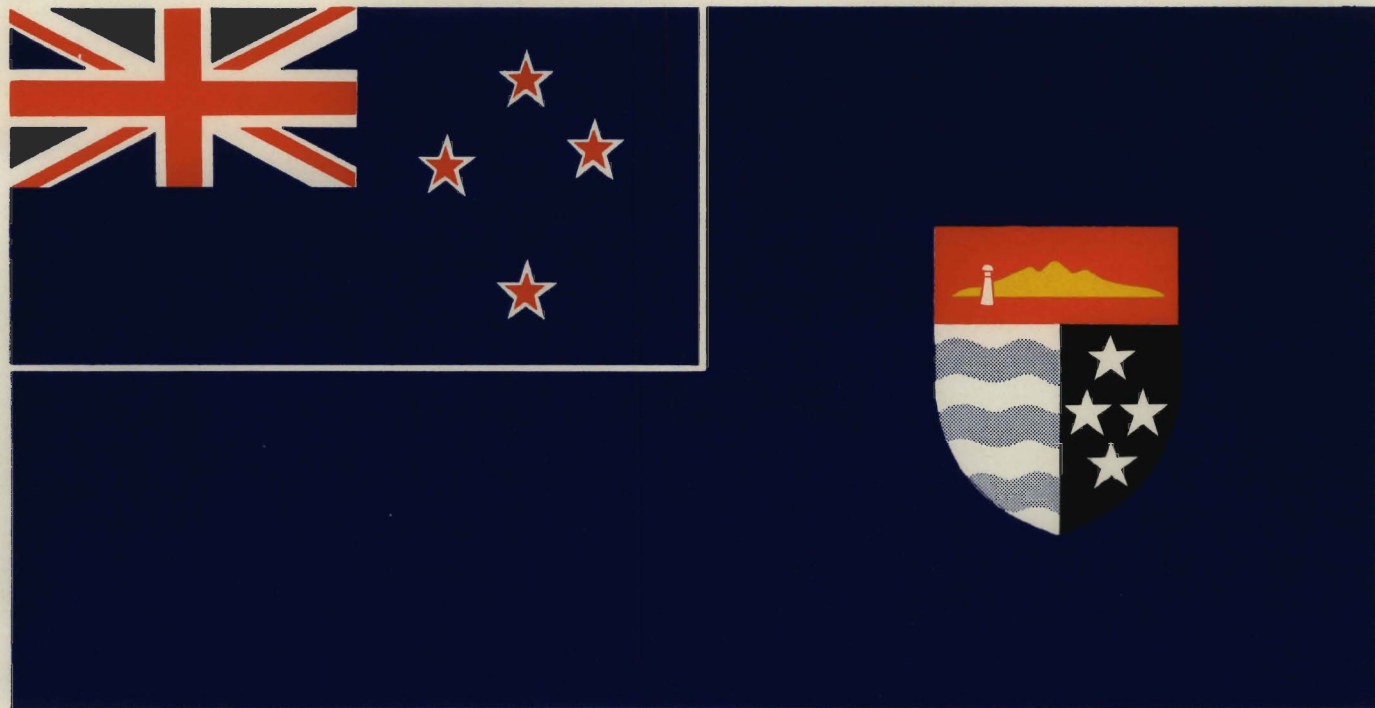
(a) The extended river limits of the Port of Auckland; and

(b) The river limits of the Port of Manukau,—
as specified in the Shipping Restricted Limits Notice 1953* or in any notice given by the Minister of Marine in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor.

The New Zealand ensign incorporated in the flag shall comply with the description of the New Zealand ensign, as set out in the notice by the Minister of Marine published in the *Gazette* on the 24th day of June 1902 at page 1348, and the dimensions of the flag shall be twice those of the New Zealand ensign incorporated therein.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations are made pursuant to section 5 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 (as amended by section 2 of the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1963), and specify the conditions in which ships owned and operated by the Auckland Harbour Board may wear a flag incorporating the New Zealand ensign.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 20 February 1964.

These regulations are administered in the Marine Department.
