## Regulations

- Title**  
These regulations are the Accident Insurance (Osteopaths) Regulations 2001.
- Commencement**  
These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Expiry**

These regulations expire on the close of 31 March 2002.

**4 Certain osteopaths are treatment providers**

Osteopaths who are members of the New Zealand Osteopathic Association Incorporated are included in the definition of **treatment provider** in section 13 of the Accident Insurance Act 1998.
