ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of September 1959

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Auckland Metropolitan Milk District Order 1959.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Auckland Metropolitan Milk District, as constituted by the Auckland Metropolitan Milk District Constitution Order 1945,* shall hereafter consist of the areas described in the First Schedule hereto; and the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the said First Schedule.

3. The Auckland Metropolitan Milk Board shall continue to be the Milk Authority for the said district.

4. The Orders in Council specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULES

FIRST SCHEDULE

THE AUCKLAND METROPOLITAN MILK DISTRICT

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District being the City of Auckland, the Boroughs of Birkenhead, Devonport, East Coast Bays, Ellerslie, Glen Eden, Henderson, Howick, Manurewa, Mount Albert, Mount Roskill, Mount Wellington, Mount Eden, New Lynn, Newmarket, Northcote, Onehunga, One Tree Hill, Otahuhu, Papakura, Papatoetoe, and Takapuna, the Road District of Waiheke, parts of the

Counties of Manukau and Waitemata, the Waitemata and Manukau Harbours and the Islands of Rangitoto, Motutapu, Waiheke, Motuihe, and other islands within the limits of the ports of Auckland and Manukau, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the mouth of the Puhoi River on the shores of the Hauraki Gulf and proceeding southerly generally along the mean high-water mark of the Hauraki Gulf and Rangitoto Channel to a point due west of the Rangitoto Beacon; thence due east along a right line across the Rangitoto Channel to and along the western and northern shores of Rangitoto Island and the north-western shores of Motutapu Island to Billy Goat Point; thence along another right line to South Point of Rakino Island and south-easterly along another right line to the northern extremity of the western entrance of Owanaki Bay, Waiheke Island; thence along the northern, eastern, and southern shores of Waiheke Island to Park Point; thence south-westerly along a right line to the eastern head of the Tamaki River (Musick Point); thence easterly and southerly generally along the shores of Tamaki Strait and along the left bank of the Wairoa River to the south-eastern corner of Allotment 113, Parish of Hunua, in Block XII, Wairoa Survey District; thence westerly generally along the boundary of the Franklin Milk District as described in the Schedule to the Franklin Milk District Order 1958 (S.R. 1958/158), and being the northern boundary of the County of Franklin to South Head at the entrance to the Manukau Harbour; thence northerly along a right line across the entrance of the Manukau Harbour to Paratutai Point and thence along the west coast to a point being the production south-westerly of a right line between Trig. Station Kopuakai in Block V, Kumeu Survey District and Trig. Station A (Lookout) in Block I, Waitemata Survey District; thence north-easterly generally along the said right line to Trig. Station A (Lookout) aforesaid and another right line to a point in Block XIV, Waiwera Survey District on the northern side of Black Bridge Road 300 links distant westerly from the western side of the Birkenhead-Maungaturoto State Highway No. 5; thence along a series of right lines parallel to and 300 links distant from that highway to the western side of Whitehills Road; thence along a right line to the point of intersection of the middle lines of the Wainui-Silverdale Road and a public road passing through Allotment 22, Parish of Waiwera; thence along the middle of the Wainui-Silverdale Road aforesaid to and along the middle of the Upper Orewa Road and the middle of the Helensville-Waiwera Main Highway to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Part Allotment 110, Parish of Waiwera on D.P. 7531 in Block III, Waiwera Survey District; thence along a right line to and along the aforesaid eastern boundary and along another right line across the Waiwera River to a point on the north-eastern side of the Birkenhead-Maungaturoto State Highway No. 5, being the western-most corner of that part of Puhoi Block on D.P. 11077, containing 159 acres 2 roods 30 perches; thence continuing northerly along the eastern side of a public road forming the western boundaries of the last-mentioned block and the closed road shown on S.O. Plan 16344, and continuing along the western boundaries of the said Puhoi Block and Section 1, Block IV, Waiwera Survey District and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Puhoi River; thence down the middle of that river to the point of commencement.

The effect of this order is to include, the Silverdale, Riverhead, Waimauku, and Muriwai areas, and also Rangitoto Island, within the Auckland Metropolitan Milk District. The order redefines the milk district which is under the jurisdiction of the Auckland Metropolitan Milk Board.
