**THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS (MARKET GARDENS)
EXTENSION ORDER 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Workers Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th day of September 1964.

2. (1) Clause 1 of the First Schedule to the principal order (as amended by clause 2 of the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (4) the words "allowance of 5s.", and substituting the words "allowance of 5s. 4d."

(2) Clause 2 of the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.

3. (1) Clause 4 of the First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1) (as substituted by clause 4 of the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following subclause:

(2) Clause 4 of the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.

4. (1) The Second Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 3 (as substituted by clause 8 of the Agricultural Workers (Market Gardens) Extension Order 1960, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following clause:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases by 6 per cent as from 10 September 1964 the minimum rates of wages and the meal allowance payable to agricultural workers employed in market gardens (including market gardens where soft fruit is produced) following the Court of Arbitration's General Wage Order dated the 19th day of August 1964.
