



**THE AGRICULTURAL WORKERS LABOUR LEGISLATION  
SUSPENSION ORDER 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Labour Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940,\* the Minister of Labour doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Agricultural Workers Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1941, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Workers Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1941† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Clause 4 of the principal Order, as substituted by clause 2 of the Agricultural Workers Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1941, Amendment No. 1‡, is revoked, and the following clause substituted therefor :—

“ 4. The minimum rates of wages payable to the workers referred to in clause 2 hereof shall be as follows :—

“ First six months . . .	2	11	0 (plus keep)	2	6	0 (plus keep)
“ Thereafter . . .	2	18	6 (plus keep)	2	13	6 (plus keep).”

3. The Agricultural Workers Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1941, Amendment No. 1‡, is revoked.

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1st day of June, 1945.
