THE BUTTER AND CHEESE MARKETING REGULATIONS

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of April 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Production and Marketing Board Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Butter and Cheese Marketing Regulations 1948, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Butter and Cheese Marketing Regulations 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Subclause (3) of regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

(a) By inserting, before the definition of the term "butter", the following definition:

"Board" means the New Zealand Dairy Production and Marketing Board established under the Dairy Production and Marketing Board Act 1961:"

(b) By revoking the definition of the term "Commission".

3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 31, and substituting the following regulation:

"31. (1) Not later than the 30th day of June in every year each manufacturer of butter shall deliver to the Board for the year ended on the immediately preceding 31st day of May a certified statement signed by a registered accountant, not being a servant or agent of the manufacturer, reconciling the quantities of butter entered by the manufacturer in the returns delivered to the Board by the manufacturer pursuant to

regulation 29 of these regulations with the quantities of butter ascertained to have been manufactured by the manufacturer for the purposes of the certified statement to be given under section 22 of the Dairy Industry Act 1952.

“(2) Not later than the 30th day of June in every year each manufacturer of cheese shall deliver to the Board for the year ended on the immediately preceding 31st day of May a certified statement signed by a registered accountant, not being a servant or agent of the manufacturer, reconciling the quantities of cheese entered by the manufacturer in the returns delivered to the Board by the manufacturer pursuant to regulation 5 of the Dairy-Produce Levy Regulations 1948* with the quantities of cheese ascertained to have been manufactured by the manufacturer for the purposes of the certified statement to be given under section 22 of the Dairy Industry Act 1952.”

4. (1) The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from Form No. 1 the words “To the New Zealand Dairy Products Marketing Commission, Wellington C. 1.”, and substituting the words “To the New Zealand Dairy Production and Marketing Board, Wellington C. 1.”.

(2) The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from Form No. 2 the words “Chairman (General Manager), N.Z. Dairy Products Marketing Commission”, and substituting the words “Chairman (General Manager (Marketing)), New Zealand Dairy Production and Marketing Board”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations change (from 31 August to 30 June) the last date on which manufacturers of butter and cheese are to make returns reconciling the quantities of butter and cheese entered by the manufacturer with the quantities ascertained to have been manufactured by him. The period to which the returns relate has been correspondingly altered.
