



BIOSECURITY (FORMS) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1998

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 165 (x) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Biosecurity (Forms) Amendment Regulations 1998, and are part of the Biosecurity (Forms) Regulations 1995* (“the principal regulations”).

(2) These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Certain forms prescribed—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended—

(a) By omitting the expression “(1)”;

(b) By omitting from the last paragraph the expression “(b)”, and substituting the expression “(d)”.

3. Amendments to forms—(1) Form A in the Schedule of the principal regulations is amended—

- (a) By inserting, after the words “TO ENTER” in the heading of that Form, the words “AND INSPECT”:
- (b) By inserting, after the words “to enter” in the text of that Form, the words “and inspect”:
- (c) By omitting the third and fourth bullet point items, and substituting the following item:
“● risk goods”.

(2) Form B in the Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the word “inspector” wherever it appears, the words “or authorised person”.

(3) Paragraph 1 of the Notes of Form C in the Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the words “Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries”, and substituting the words “Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, correct a minor error in the Biosecurity (Forms) Regulations 1995 and make minor changes to the forms in those regulations. The changes are a consequence of the changes made to the Biosecurity Act 1993 by the Biosecurity Amendment Act 1997 and the change made to the name of the Ministry.
