



**THE BROADCASTING (PUBLIC BROADCASTING FEES)
REGULATIONS 1989, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 15th day of October 1990

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 82 of the Broadcasting Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Broadcasting (Public Broadcasting Fees) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Broadcasting (Public Broadcasting Fees) Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1990.

2. Interpretation—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, before the definition of the term “hospital”, the following definition:

“‘Guaranteed retirement income earner’ means a person receiving guaranteed retirement income.”.

(2) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term “national superannuitant”.

(3) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term “television set”, the following definition:

“‘Veteran’s pensioner’ means a person receiving a veteran’s pension.”.

3. Concessional amounts payable by certain guaranteed retirement income earners and veterans’ pensioners—Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (1) the words “national superannuitant’s”, and substituting the words “guaranteed retirement income earner’s or veteran’s pensioner’s”:

(b) By omitting the words “national superannuitant” wherever they occur, and substituting in each case the words “guaranteed retirement income earner or veteran’s pensioner”.

4. New Second Schedule—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

DECLARATION TO BE COMPLETED BY GUARANTEED RETIREMENT INCOME
EARNER OR VETERAN'S PENSIONER WISHING TO PAY CONCESSIONAL
AMOUNT OF PUBLIC BROADCASTING FEE

- Information in the records of the Department of Social Welfare that shows whether or not I am the only person residing in my home at the above address.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations, which come into force on 1 November 1990, provide for—

- (a) A change from the term "national superannuitant" to the new term "guaranteed retirement income earner"; and
- (b) The inclusion of veterans' pensioners within the class of persons who may claim concessional rates for the public broadcasting fee.
