This order is the Bluff Harbour Improvement (Grant of Reclaimed Land) Order 2003.

3 Reclaimed land granted to South Port New Zealand Limited

- (1) In the name of and on behalf of the Crown, the land described in subclause (2) is granted to South Port New Zealand Limited.
- (2) The land comprises 6.4700 hectares, being section 1 SO 11396, situated in Block 1, Campbelltown Hundred, Southland Land District.

Explanatory note
