



**THE BAKING INDUSTRY LABOUR LEGISLATION SUSPENSION
ORDER 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

IN pursuance of the Labour Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940, the Minister of Labour doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Baking Industry Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1942, Amendment No. 1.

2. This Order shall be read together with and deemed part of the Baking Industry Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1942* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

3. The principal Order is amended by revoking paragraph (2) of clause 3 thereof, and substituting therefor the following paragraph :—

“(2) The minimum rate of wages shall be the minimum rate prescribed for bakers’ labourers by the Bakers and Pastrycooks and their Labourers’ award for the time being in force.”

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 26th day of October, 1944.
