Pursuant to section 3 of the Trade Arrangement (New Zealand and Belgium) Ratification Act, 1933, and to all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:-
