AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of October 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 302 of the Customs Act 1913 and section 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Cook Islands Customs Duties Order 1962, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cook Islands Customs Duties Order 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting so much thereof as relates to the items of Group 332 of the Customs Tariff, and substituting the heading, subheadings, items, and rates of duty set out in the Schedule hereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The amendment made by this order is a change in nomenclature only, and does not affect rates of duty.

The order substitutes (in relation to the Cook Islands) a new wording relating to certain petroleum products, and is consequential on alterations in the Customs Tariff made by the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 4) 1964, which, except for the items dealt with in this order, also applies to the Cook Islands.
