Order

1 Title

- (1) This order is the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Amendment Order 2001.
- (2) In this order, the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 1998¹ is called “the principal order”.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 6 April 2001.

3 Expiry of principal order

Clause 1A of the principal order is amended by omitting the expression “7 April 2001”, and substituting the expression “7 July 2001”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 1998. That order prohibits the importation of trout and trout products in quantities of 10 or more kilograms, or less than 10 kilograms if the trout or trout products are intended for sale. The amendment extends by 3 months the duration of the prohibition.
