**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 30th day of November  
1964

**THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

---

**O R D E R**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Insecticides) Order 1964.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The importation of the goods specified in the Schedule hereto is prohibited, except with the consent of the Minister of Customs and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit to impose.

Benzene hexachloride.

Dichlorodiphenyltrichlorethane (DDT).
