THE CENTRAL MILK COUNCIL (FEES AND TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 1945

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of August, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Central Milk Council (Fees and Travelling-allowances) Regulations 1945.

2. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941* shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Central Milk Council established under the Milk Act, 1944, and its members and to any Committee thereof, and the members of any such Committee.

3. The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 4 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941 shall be after the rate of £1 5s. a day.

4. The rate of the mileage-allowance referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941 for journeys performed in a motor-vehicle shall be 6d. a mile.

5. The actual garage expenses referred to in Regulation 11 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941 shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night.

6. The remuneration by way of fees or allowances referred to in section 99 of the said Act shall be—

- (a) For each day or part of a day on which a member is in attendance at a meeting of the Council or of any Committee thereof, a sum of £2 2s. :
- (b) For any time in which a member is otherwise actually engaged in transacting any business of the Council or of any Committee thereof, a payment after the rate of £2 2s. for a day of twenty-four hours.
