



**THE CUSTOMS PORTS OF ENTRY NOTICE 1980,
AMENDMENT NO. 5**

PURSUANT to section 26 of the Customs Act 1966, the General Manager, Commercial Operations, of the Customs Department, in accordance with the power delegated to that General Manager by the Minister of Customs under section 9 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Ports of Entry Notice 1980, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Ports of Entry Notice 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1990.

2. Port of entry—(1) It is hereby declared that Waverley shall cease to be a port of entry for the purposes of the Customs Acts.

(2) The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the item relating to Waverley (as inserted by clause 2 of the Customs Ports of Entry Notice 1980, Amendment No. 1).

(3) The Customs Ports of Entry Notice 1980, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to Waverley.
