THE CUSTOMS REGULATIONS 1959, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of July 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1964.

2. Regulation 13 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from paragraph (a) the expression “15s.”, and substituting the expression “19s.”:

(b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the expression “12s.”, and substituting the expression “14s.”.

3. Regulation 14 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “8s.”, and substituting the expression “9s. 6d.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

The amendments made by regulation 2 of these regulations increase the charges payable to the Customs Department for the attendance of officers of Customs outside working hours (for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of the Customs Acts) from 15s. an hour to 19s. an hour on Sundays or Customs holidays, and from 12s. an hour to 14s. an hour on other days.

The amendment made by regulation 3 of these regulations increases the prescribed charges payable to the Department for attendance during working hours (to perform or supervise any operation) from 8s. an hour to 9s. 6d. an hour.
