**THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER (NO. 2)
1964**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of May 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921 and sections 5 and 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961 and heretofore modified) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner generally to the public interest, and that certain provisions of the notes forming part of the Tariff are likely to operate in a manner that is detrimental to the proper operation of the Tariff, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1964.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1964.

2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

4. The note to the Tariff specified in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby amended in the manner indicated in that Schedule.

5. This order shall be in force in the Cook Islands.

AMENDMENT TO THE NOTES TO THE TARIFF

Portion of Tariff	Amendment
Group 841	By omitting note 4, and substituting the following note: "4. For the purposes of items 841.110.3 to 841.141.9 (except item 841.141.1), articles which cannot be identified as either men's or boys' garments or as women's or girls' garments are to be classified in items 841.120.2 to 841.121.9, and 841.140.2 to 841.140.9, 841.141.8, and 841.141.9, as the case may be."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order suspends the portions of the Customs Tariff set out in the First Schedule, and substitutes the Tariff items set out in the Second Schedule.

The alteration to the note set out in the Third Schedule is consequential.

The order is to be in force in the Cook Islands.

The order comes into force on 1 July 1964.
