**THE CUSTOMS TARIFF AMENDMENT ORDER
(NO. 5) 1964**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of October 1964

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Customs Amendment Act 1921 and sections 5 and 6 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that the rates of duty and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, being rates and exemptions specified in the Customs Tariff (as set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1961 and heretofore modified) are likely to operate in an injurious, unfair, or anomalous manner either generally to the public interest or particularly to certain industries, trades, or businesses carried on in New Zealand, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 5) 1964.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The portions of the Customs Tariff specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby suspended.

3. The duties set out in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby imposed, and the exemptions from duty in that Schedule are hereby created.

4. The Tariff is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

5. This order shall be in force in the Cook Islands.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Customs Tariff in respect of pneumatic mattresses, pillows, and cushions.

Clause 2 suspends the portions of the Tariff set out in the First Schedule.

Clause 3 substitutes for the portions of the Tariff so suspended the new items set out in the Second Schedule.

Clause 4 makes consequential amendments to notes and headings of the Tariff, as set out in the Third Schedule.

Clause 5 applies this order to the Cook Islands.
