## THE CITRUS TREES DISEASES REGULATIONS 1959

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of August 1959

Present:

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Citrus Trees Diseases Regulations 1959.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Except with the consent of the Director-General of Agriculture, no person shall remove or cause to be removed any citrus plant (other than citrus fruit), or any citrus seed intended for propagation, or any plant capable of being used as a root stock for citrus plants, from any place in New Zealand outside the area hereinafter specified into that area, being the area that consists of the Provincial District of Auckland, the Borough of Wairoa, and the part of the County of Wairoa that lies outside the Provincial District of Auckland.

3. The Citrus Trees Diseases Regulations 1957\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

Under the Citrus Trees Diseases Regulations 1957 it is forbidden to remove citrus plants, citrus seed, and root stock for citrus plants from any place in New Zealand outside the Provincial District of Auckland into that Provincial District. These regulations extend the protected area by taking in the Borough of Wairoa and the part of the County of Wairoa that lies outside the Provincial District of Auckland.
