



**THE DRAINAGE AND PLUMBING EXTENSION NOTICE 1945,
NO. 3**

Department of Health,
Wellington, 15th October, 1945.

PURSUANT to section 133 of the Health Act, 1920, and pursuant to regulations made under that Act on the 3rd day of September, 1923, and to be cited as the Drainage and Plumbing Regulations,* I, Arnold Henry Nordmeyer, Minister of Health, hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Drainage and Plumbing Extension Notice 1945, No. 3.

2. This notice shall take effect as from the 31st day of October, 1945.

3. The Drainage and Plumbing Regulations* aforesaid are hereby applied to the County of Bay of Islands.

4. The Drainage and Plumbing Extension Consolidation Notice 1941† is accordingly amended as follows: Part III of the Second Schedule thereto (as heretofore amended) is amended by inserting therein, under the heading "North Auckland Health District", and next preceding the item "Mangonui (the whole county) 26th April, 1945", the following additional item:—

" Bay of Islands (the whole county) . . . 31st October, 1945."
