## Regulations

### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the District Courts Fees Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the District Courts Fees Regulations 2001<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 29 June 2001.

**3 Commencement of principal regulations**

Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “1 July”, and substituting the expression “1 October”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 29 June 2001, defer the commencement of the District Courts Fees Regulations 2001 from 1 July 2001 until 1 October 2001. The effect of the deferral is that, until 1 October 2001, the fees payable in District Courts will continue to be governed by the District Courts Fees Regulations 1997 (SR 1997/324).
