**THE DANGEROUS GOODS (LICENSING AUTHORITIES)
REGULATIONS 1958, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 24th day of March 1959

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Authorities) Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Dangerous Goods (Licensing Authorities) Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1959.

2. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting so much of Part I as relates to County Councils, and substituting the following words:

“COUNTY COUNCILS

Awatere	Kaikoura	Waimate
Clutha	Manukau	Waimea
Hawke's Bay	Southland	Whakatane
Hokianga	Tauranga	Whangaroa”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is that, in addition to the counties already specified in the principal regulations, those regulations will have effect as bylaws in the Counties of Clutha, Hawke's Bay, Tauranga, Waimate, and Waimea.
