THE DANGEROUS GOODS ORDER 1959

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 24th day of March 1959

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1959.

2. The Second Schedule to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 (as amended by clause 4 (b) of the Dangerous Goods Order 1958) is hereby further amended by inserting in that part of the Schedule that relates to County Councils, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Clutha", "Hawke's Bay", "Tauranga", "Waimate", and "Waimea".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to declare the Clutha, Hawke's Bay, Tauranga, Waimate, and Waimea County Councils to be licensing authorities under the Dangerous Goods Act 1957.
