THE DANGEROUS GOODS ORDER 1964

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of May 1964

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dangerous Goods Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Dangerous Goods Order 1964.
2. The Second Schedule of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957 is hereby amended—
 - (a) By inserting in that part of that Schedule that relates to Borough Councils, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words “Murupara” and “Porirua”;
 - (b) By inserting in that part of that Schedule that relates to County Councils (as amended by the Dangerous Goods Order 1959*), in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words “Cook” and “Murchison”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is to constitute the following local authorities licensing authorities for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1957:

The Murupara Borough Council
The Porirua Borough Council
The Cook County Council
The Murchison County Council.
