This order is the Extradition Amendment Act Commencement Order 2003.
- Commencement of provisions implementing TOC Convention**

Sections 5 and 6 of the Extradition Amendment Act 2002, so far as they implement the TOC convention (as defined in

section 101B of the Extradition Act 1999), come into force on 29 September 2003.

3 Commencement of provisions implementing migrants protocol and trafficking protocol

Sections 5 and 6 of the Extradition Amendment Act 2002, so far as they implement the migrants protocol (as defined in section 101B of the Extradition Act 1999) and so far as they implement the trafficking protocol (as so defined), come into force on 1 January 2004.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, for certain purposes, sections 5 and 6 of the Extradition Amendment Act 2002.

Those sections, so far as they implement the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organised Crime (the “TOC convention”), come into force on 29 September 2003.

Those sections, so far as they implement the Protocol against the Smuggling of Migrants, by Land, Sea and Air (the “migrants protocol”) and so far as they implement the Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking of Persons, especially Women and Children (the “trafficking protocol”), come into force on 1 January 2004.
