ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Examination and Certification of Teachers Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Examination and Certification of Teachers Regulations 1961\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:

“(2) The fee payable for the Trained Teachers Certificate Examination shall be 18s. for each subject.”

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 16, the following heading and regulation:

*“Re-marking of Papers*

“16A. At any time within one month after being notified of his examination results, a student may, on the payment of a fee of £1 4s. in respect of any subject, have his papers in that subject of the examination re-marked by the examiner. If as a result his marks in that subject are increased, the fee shall be refunded to him.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations prescribe revised examination fees, and make provision for the re-marking of examination papers.
