**THE HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1.** These regulations may be cited as the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2.** (1) Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the proviso to subclause (2) the expression “£100”, and substituting the expression “£120”.

(2) Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of subclause (3) the expression “£50”, and substituting the expression “£60”.

(3) Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (4) the words “three years of service”, and substituting the words “such period of service, being not less than two years, as the Director may approve”.

(4) Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (5), and substituting the following subclause:

“(5) A teacher on his second permanent appointment to a school or manual training centre approved for country service where the transfer is from a school or centre not so approved may, in special circumstances with the prior approval of the Director, be refunded the cost of the actual and reasonable expenses of his removal to that position. Where the cost of the teacher’s removal is so refunded and he subsequently completes three years’ service in the position to which he was so appointed or in that position and in any other permanent position or positions in schools or manual training centres approved by the Director for the purpose, he may, on the first occasion thereafter on which he transfers to another permanent position in the Education service, be refunded the cost of the actual and reasonable expenses of his removal to that position:

“Provided that a payment made under this subclause for the cost of the conveyance of a teacher’s household furniture and effects shall in no case exceed £120.”

(5) Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding the following subclause:

“(7) For the purpose of this regulation the term “Education service” means employment in any position—

“(a) As a teacher in a public school, intermediate school, intermediate department, Maori school, manual training class, or post-primary school:

“(b) As a teacher in any school or specialist service under the control of the Department of Education:

“(c) As an itinerant teacher or a teacher of a special subject in the Department of Education or under an Education Board:

“(d) On the teaching staff of a teachers’ training College.”

**3.** (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 29, as amended by regulation 7 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and substituting the following regulation:

“29. The Board may, with the approval of the Senior Inspector, appoint an additional assistant if for any consecutive period of four weeks the average roll increases to a number which, if it had been attained as the average roll for the days on which the school was open during the first four weeks of the third term of the year immediately preceding, would have entitled the school to an additional assistant:

“Provided that where any such increase occurs in the average roll number of a school, the Board may, with the approval of the Senior Inspector, add an assistant to the staff of the school at any time before the expiry of the period of four consecutive weeks, if—

“(a) The Board and the Senior Inspector are satisfied that the increase is a permanent one; and

“(b) The appointment is made on a relieving basis until increase in the average roll number of the school has been maintained for four consecutive weeks; and

“(c) Teaching accommodation is available for such an appointment.”

(2) Regulation 7 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.

**4.** (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules, as substituted by regulation 3 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and substituting the First and Second Schedules set out in the First Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, are hereby consequentially revoked.

(3) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1961.

**5.** The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the Eleventh Schedule, as substituted by regulation 13 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and substituting the Eleventh Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations vary the provisions of the principal regulations governing positions of responsibility and the payment of removal expenses. They set out revised salary scales, and provide for staff adjustments where rises occur in school rolls between yearly grading periods.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 20 February 1964.

These regulations are administered in the Department of Education.
