ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 23rd day of March 1964

PURSUANT to the Workers' Compensation Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1964.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Employers' Liability Insurance Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the items relating to paint and varnish manufacturers, painters (including paperhangers, decorators, glaziers, and signwriters), and tea merchants, and substituting therefor respectively, in the appropriate columns thereof, the following items:

"Paint and varnish manufacturer	318	30	0
"Painter (including paperhanger, decorator, glazier, signwriter)	368	35	0
"Tea merchant	620/1	16	0".
