THE EDUCATION REGULATIONS REVOCATION ORDER 1945

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of
May, 1945

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Education Regulations Revocation Order 1945.

2. (1) The regulations contained in the several Orders in Council referred to in the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked to the extent indicated in the said Schedule.

(2) The revocation of any regulation in accordance with this Order shall take effect or be deemed to have taken effect on the date of the coming into force of the corresponding or superseding provisions contained in the Education (Post-primary Teachers) Regulations 1945* or the Education (Manual-training Teachers) Regulations 1945†.

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, references in any other regulations to regulations revoked by this Order shall be read as references to the corresponding provisions of the regulations referred to in the last preceding subclause.
