THE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS REVOCATION ORDER NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 28th day of November, 1945

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order

ORDER

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Emergency Regulations Revocation Order No. 2.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1945:

Provided that—

- (a) The revocation of the Cinematograph Operators Emergency Regulations 1943 shall take effect at the expiration of six months from the termination of the war:
- (b) The revocation of the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942, the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 1, and the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942, Amendment No. 2, shall take effect at noon on the 22nd day of December, 1945:
- (c) The revocation of the Reclamation of Waste Material Emergency Regulations 1940 shall take effect on the 22nd day of December, 1945:
- . (d) The revocation of the Workers' Compensation Emergency Regulations 1941 shall take effect on the 1st day of January, 1946.

2. The regulations and Orders specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

3. (1) The following Proclamations, issued under Regulation 6 of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940,* directing the enrolment of classes of the General Reserve, are hereby revoked, namely :--
