### Regulations

#### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2002.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

## 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 11 July 2002.

## 3 Offences

Regulation 16(2) of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, before the expression “14B(2),”, the expression “14B(1),”.

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 11 July 2002, amend the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 to specify that contravention of regulation 14B(1) (which relates to taking kina after the end of the season has been notified) constitutes an offence.
