Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2004.

3 Regulation 14C revoked

Regulation 14C of the principal regulations is revoked.

4 Offences

- (1) Regulation 16(1) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “14C(1),”.
- (2) Regulation 16(2) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “14C(2) or (3),”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2004, amend the Fisheries (Central Area Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 to revoke regulation 14C, which places restrictions on the taking of sea cucumber in quota management areas 2 and 8. This species is being introduced into the quota management system on 1 April 2004.
