### Regulations

#### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Southern Bluefin Tuna Quota) Amendment Regulations 2003.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Southern Bluefin Tuna Quota) Regulations 2000<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

**2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Annual catch limits**

Regulation 6(1) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the words “2001 is 395”, and substituting the words “2003 is 387”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Fisheries (Southern Bluefin Tuna Quota) Regulations 2000 to set the annual catch limit for the 2003 fishing year at 387 greenweight tonnes. The annual catch limit for the 2002 fishing year was 420 greenweight tonnes.
