### Regulations

#### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Toothfish Catch Documentation Scheme) Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Toothfish Catch Documentation Scheme) Regulations 2000<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 October 2001.

### 3 Offences and penalties

Regulation 9(4) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “\$10,000”, and substituting the expression “\$100,000”.

#### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 2001, amend the Fisheries (Toothfish Catch Documentation Scheme) Regulations 2000 by increasing the maximum fines for offences against the regulations from \$10,000 to \$100,000.
