1 Title

- (1) This notice is the Fisheries (Beach Cast Seaweed Area Prohibition) Amendment Notice 2004.
- (2) In this notice, the Fisheries (Beach Cast Seaweed Area Prohibition) Notice 2002¹ is called “the principal notice”.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 1 October 2004.

3 Prohibition on taking beach cast seaweed from coastal areas

The table in clause 4 of the principal notice is amended by omitting from the item relating to FMA 9 the words “Tauroa Point (approximately 35°10.0’S and 173°03.7’E)”, and substituting the words “a point located at the northern end of Kahokawa Beach (at 34°31.6’S and 172°43.5’E)”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 October 2004, amends the Fisheries (Beach Cast Seaweed Area Prohibition) Notice 2002 to allow commercial fishers to take beach cast seaweed from Ninety Mile Beach.
