## Regulations

### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 2001<sup>1</sup> are called “the principal regulations”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2004, amend the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 2001. The amendments omit from Schedule 5 of the regulations references to species of surf clam that are being introduced into the quota management system on 1 April 2004.
