Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations (No 5) 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 2001¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 14 January 2005.

3 Offences

Regulation 84(3) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “75(1)”, and substituting the expression “75”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 2001 (“the principal regulations”). They come into force on 14 January 2005.

The amendment makes a technical drafting correction to clarify the scope of the offence arising under regulation 75 of the principal regulations.
