



**THE FISHERIES (LICENSED FISH RECEIVERS) REGULATIONS
1986, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Licensed Fish Receivers) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Licensed Fish Receivers) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1990.

2. Licensing of fish receivers—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2).

3. Offences—The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding the following regulation:

“13. (1) Every person commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, regulation 3 of these regulations, or who fails to comply with any lawful requirement made by the Director-General under these regulations.

“(2) Every offence against regulation 3 of these regulations shall be a quota management offence for the purposes of the Act.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1990, amend the offence provisions in the Fisheries (Licensed Fish Receivers) Regulations 1986.

New regulation 13, which relates to offences, is added to the principal regulations. The new regulation—

- (a) Continues the offence of fish receiving without an appropriate licence (which was formerly in regulation 3 of the principal regulations); and
- (b) Adds a new offence of failing to comply with any lawful requirement of the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries; and
- (c) Prescribes a penalty of a fine not exceeding \$10,000 for both offences; and
- (d) Provides that the offence of fish receiving is a quota management offence for the purposes of the Fisheries Act 1983.
