## Notice

### 1 Title

- (1) This notice is the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catches) Amendment Notice 2005.
- (2) In this notice, the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catches) Notice 1999<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal notice”.

### 2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 1 April 2005.

### 3 Schedule amended

The third column of the Schedule of the principal notice is amended by omitting the expression “327.000”, and substituting the expression “190.000”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which comes into force on 1 April 2005, amends the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catches) Notice 1999.

The amendment decreases the total allowable commercial catch for spiny rock lobster for the Gisborne quota management area from 327 to 190 tonnes.
