Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Amendment Regulations 2002.
- (2) In these regulations the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2001¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 11 July 2002.

3 Schedule 1 amended

Schedule 1 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in their appropriate order, in the table that relates to the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001 (SR 2001/188), the following items:

Provision	Description of offence	Fee (\$)
r 6(3A)	In the case of a catch landing return due not later than the 15th day after the last day of the fishing trip, providing the return between the 16th and 20th days after the last day of the fishing trip (both days inclusive)	400
r 6(3A)	In the case of a catch landing return due not later than the 15th day after the last day of the fishing trip, providing the return between 6 days and 1 calendar month after the date it was due (both dates inclusive)	750
r 6(3A)	In the case of a catch landing return due not later than 15 days after the last day of the calendar month, providing the return between the 16th and the 20th days after the last day of the calendar month (both days inclusive)	400
r 6(3A)	In the case of a catch landing return due not later than 15 days after the last day of the calendar month, providing the return between the 21st day of that month and the 15th day of the following month (both days inclusive)	750
r 6(4)	Failing to provide a nil catch landing return	400
r 11(3)	In the case of a trawl catch, effort, and processing return due not later than the 15th day after the last day of the fishing trip, providing the return between the 16th and 20th days after the last day of the fishing trip (both days inclusive)	400
r 11(3)	In the case of a trawl catch, effort, and processing return due not later than the 15th day after the last day of the fishing trip, providing the return between 6 days and 1 calendar month after the date it was due (both dates inclusive)	750
r 12(3)	In the case of a squid jigging catch effort return due not later than the 15th day after the last day of the fishing trip, providing the return between the 16th and 20th days after the last day of the fishing trip (both days inclusive)	400
r 12(3)	In the case of a squid jigging catch effort return due not later than the 15th day after the last day of the fishing trip, providing the return between 6 days and 1 calendar month after the date it was due (both dates inclusive)	750
r 13(3)	In the case of a tuna longlining catch effort return due not later than 15 days after the last day of the calendar month, providing the return between the 16th and 20th days after the last day of the calendar month (both days inclusive)	400

Provision	Description of offence	Fee (\$)
r 13(3)	In the case of a tuna longlining catch effort return due not later than 15 days after the last day of the calendar month, providing the return between the 21st day of that month and the 15th day of the following month (both days inclusive)	750
r 20(4)	Failing to carry out an audit of a newly licensed fish receiver after the date it was due but not more than 1 calendar month after the date it was due	400

Explanatory note

These regulations, which come into force on 11 July 2002, prescribe new infringement offences and infringement fees for the purposes of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001.
