Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2002.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2001¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 31 August 2002.

3 Schedule 1 amended

Schedule 1 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the item that relates to regulation 5A(2), from the table headed Fisheries (Central Area Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 (SR 1986/223).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 31 August 2002, amend Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2001 by revoking the item that relates to the offence of taking or possessing 1 or more rock lobsters, but not more than 6 rock lobsters, in contravention of regulation 5A(1) of the Fisheries (Central Area Amateur Fishing Regulations) 1986.
